That in the County of Wyandotte, State of Kansas between October 15, 2007 and November 2, 2007, Marc Conklin, while a public officer or public employee and knowing that such claim or demand was false or fraudulent in whole or in part, did unlawfully audit, allow, or pay a claim or demand for at least \$1,000 but less than \$25,000, to-wit: \$4,650, made upon a governmental instrumentality within the state, in violation of K.S.A. 21-3905. (Permitting a False Claim, Severity Level 9 Nonperson Felony)

#### **COUNT FIFTY-THREE**

That in the County of Wyandotte, State of Kansas on or about the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 2007, Marc Conklin, while a public officer or public employee and knowing that such claim or demand was false or fraudulent in whole or in part, did unlawfully audit, allow, or pay a claim or demand for at least \$1,000 but less than \$25,000, to-wit: \$4,425, made upon a governmental instrumentality within the state, in violation of K.S.A. 21-3905. (Permitting a False Claim, Severity Level 9 Nonperson Felony)

#### **COUNT FIFTY-FOUR**

That in the County of Wyandotte, State of Kansas between December 4, 2007, and December 31, 2007, Marc Conklin, while a public officer or public employee and knowing that such claim or demand was false or fraudulent in whole or in part, did unlawfully audit, allow, or pay a claim or demand for at least \$1,000 but less than \$25,000, to-wit: \$3,750, made upon a governmental instrumentality within the state, in violation of K.S.A. 21-3905. (Permitting a False Claim, Severity Level 9 Nonperson Felony)

#### **COUNT FIFTY-FIVE**

That in the County of Wyandotte, State of Kansas between January 3, 2008, and January 4, 2008, Marc Conklin, while a public officer or public employee and knowing that such claim or demand was false or fraudulent in whole or in part, did unlawfully audit, allow, or pay a claim or demand for at least \$1,000 but less than \$25,000, to-wit: \$6,900, made upon a governmental instrumentality within the state, in violation of K.S.A. 21-3905. (Permitting a False Claim, Severity Level 9 Nonperson Felony)

### **COUNT FIFTY-SIX**

That in the County of Wyandotte, State of Kansas on or about the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February, 2008, Marc Conklin, while a public officer or public employee and knowing that such claim or demand was false or fraudulent in whole or in part, did unlawfully audit, allow, or pay a claim or demand for at least \$1,000 but less than \$25,000, to-wit: \$8,400, made upon a governmental instrumentality within the state, in violation of K.S.A. 21-3905. (Permitting a False Claim, Severity Level 9 Nonperson Felony)

### **COUNT FIFTY-SEVEN**

That in the County of Wyandotte, State of Kansas on or about the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2008, Marc Conklin, while a public officer or public employee and knowing that such claim or demand was false or fraudulent in whole or in part, did unlawfully audit, allow, or pay a claim or demand for at least \$1,000 but less than \$25,000, to-wit: \$8,850, made upon a governmental instrumentality within the state, in violation of K.S.A. 21-3905. (Permitting a False Claim, Severity Level 9 Nonperson Felony)

A true bill.
